No. SO(IS-I)HD/NAP/2021: In pursuance of the Revised National Action Plan (NAP), 2021 and in particular, the decision made during the Central APEX Committee meeting held on 19th November, 2024, for the effective implementation of Central and Provincial APEX Committees meeting decisions, the following DISTRICT COORDINATION COMMITTEE is hereby constituted with immediate effect:

In alignment with the goals set forth in the Revised National Action Plan (R-NAP) (2021), the District Coordination Committee will execute the following actions across the district:

Execution of Policy Decisions:

Objective: Ensure that the policies of the R-NAP 2021 decided by Central APEX and Provincial APEX Committees, aimed at strengthening the security framework, are swiftly and effectively executed at the district level

Actions:

Implement and enforce security policies relating to the prevention of extremism, terrorism, and other unlawful activities

Coordinate between law enforcement agencies to enhance overall security

Regularly assess the evolving threats and update measures as needed.

Implementation of Law and Regulations in Respective Districts:

Objective: Support the effective enforcement of local laws, regulations, and security protocols.

Actions:

Coordinate with local law enforcement agencies to ensure compliance

Monitoring the implementation of district specific regulations under NAP

Implement Decisions Made by the Central/ Provincial APEX Committee:

Objective: Act as the conduit for implementation of policies and decisions made by the Central/Provincial APEX Committees.



## Actions

- Ensure that all decisions taken by the Central/ Provincial APEX Committees are communicated to the district level for implementation
- Keep a record of the implementation progress and report to the Provincial or Federal Authorities (through office of the Home Secretary)

# Coordinate Action Against:

Smuggling, Narcotics, Power Theft and other illegal spectrum activities

o Objective: Eliminate smuggling networks, curb drug related activities, prevent power theft and all illegal spectrum activities

### o Actions:

- Conduct raids and enforce laws on smuggling and narcotics distribution
- Anti-Narcotics Force to work with Excise, Taxation & Narcotics Control Dept (being the lead agency) for action against narcotics under the CNS Act, 2024
- Work with Customs and Law Enforcement to identify and take action against smuggling operations
- To prevent human trafficking under the Prevention of Trafficking in Persons Act, 2018
- Initiate community to identify campaigns to prevent power theft

### Non-Customs Paid (NCP) Items/Warehouses: 5.

- Objective: Curb the illegal trade of NCP goods, vehicles and enforce regulations around illegal warehouses.
- Actions:
  - Target warehouses dealing in smuggled goods and NCP items including Vehicles.
  - Coordinate with Excise, Taxation & Narcotics Control Dept. and Customs for intelligence sharing and action

#### Illegal Petrol Pump: 6.

- Objective: Curb sale of illegal petrol through illegal petrol pumps
- Actions: Collaborate with relevant departments to identify and close illegal petrol pumps

### Ensure Registration of Madaris: 7.

- Objective: Bring all religious seminaries under regulatory oversight to ensure they comply with provincial education standards and counter extremism activities
- Actions:
- Ensure all madaris are duly registered/ geo tagged with the relevant
  - Implement the National Action Plan's reforms for Madrassah education ensuring that they contribute to national peace and
  - Facilitate the regulation and oversight of mosque activities in line with legal guidelines
  - To verify the number of local and foreign mohtamams (teachers), as well as the source of funding received for each madaris
  - To check the number of local and foreign students and mohtamams, including those who are illegal and may need to be repatriated

Organization of Illegal Foreigners

Objective: To repatriate all the illegal foreigners under the Illegal Foreigners Repatriation Plan issued by the Ministry of Interior

## Action:

- Repatriation of illegal foreigners under the Phase 1
- Action against Visa Overstay foreigners through local police
- Mapping of ACC and PoR holders
- Repatriation of illegal residing Madrassah Students
- Follow up progress on Fake CNICs
- Action against illegal properties/business and bank accounts held by foreigners
- Garry Out Monthly Coordination/ Review Meetings:
  - Objective: Ensure regular reviews and updates of the district's implementation of security and appropriate actions
  - Actions:
    - Conduct monthly meetings to evaluate the progress of ongoing operations
    - Discuss challenges and identify solutions to improve coordination between relevant agencies
    - Update the Provincial APEX Committee on the district's progress and share key insights

The District Coordination Committee will meet at least once in a month.
